## ABSTRACT

Part I: The course aims to present methods of active job search, suggestions for preparing an effective curriculum vitae and advice for supporting a job interview that enhances one's skills in the academic field.

Part II: The course aims to provide tips on how to effectively write a research proposal. We want to provide a brief guide on how to transform the project idea into a clear and complete document to be presented to national and international institutions in order to obtain funding.
